

September 2022 Start Up Information:

Welcome Back!! We are very excited for the start of the 2022-23 school year!

We want to ensure a smooth entry for our students. Please read the following section carefully as it fully explains how students in Grades 1 – 7 will be organized for the first week of school (our new Kindergarten families have already received specific information regarding the September gradual entry format):

- Students in Grades 1 – 7 will return to school on Tuesday, September 6th from 9:00 am – 12:15 pm
- School hours during the first week back will be as follows:
 - Tuesday: 9:00 am – 12:15 pm
 - Wednesday-Friday: 9:00 am – 3:00 pm
- **All new students (who are not new Kindergarten students) will report to the Library on Tuesday, September 6th for placement in classrooms**
- All returning students will report to the classroom line-up areas that they used during the 2021-2022 school year when they come to school on September 6th
- Students in Grades 3 – 7 will work with the teacher that they had during the 2021-22 school year
- Please note the following information for students who were in Kindergarten – Grade 2 during the 2021-22 school year:
 - **Ms. Bryjack's former Kindergarten students** will line-up outside the "Pod-A" doors (like they did last year). These students will be greeted by Ms. Bryjack, and then escorted to Ms. Porter's classroom (Room 139). These students will be dismissed by Ms. Porter at 12:15 pm from the exit doors between "Pod-E" and the Primary Undercover Area (at the back of the school). From Wednesday to Friday, these students will line-up and be dismissed from the exit doors between "Pod-E" and the Primary Undercover Area and spend their days learning in Ms. Porter's classroom
 - **Ms. McGinley's/Ms. Henriksen's former Kindergarten students** will line-up outside the "Pod-A" doors (like they did last year). These students will be greeted by Ms. McGinley, and then escorted to Ms. Cudail's classroom (B-Pod). These students will be dismissed by Ms. Cudail at 12:15 pm from the "Pod-B" doors. From Wednesday to Friday, these students will line-up and be dismissed from the "Pod-B" doors, and spend their days learning in Ms. Cudail's classroom
 - **Ms. Hunchak's former Kindergarten students** will line-up at the "Pod-A" doors (like they did last year). They will be greeted by Ms. LaRose, and then escorted to Room 138 (Ms. Hunchak's old classroom). These students will be dismissed at 12:15 pm by Ms. LaRose from the "Pod-A" doors. From Wednesday to Friday, these students will line-up and be dismissed from the "Pod-A" doors, and spend their days learning in Ms. LaRose's classroom (Ms. Hunchak's old classroom)
 - **Ms. Mann's former Kindergarten/Grade 1 students** will spend the week lining up and being dismissed from the "Pod-B" doors (like they did last year), and will spend their days learning in Ms. Mann's classroom

- **Ms. Wallingford's former Grade 1 students** will line-up at the "B-Pod" doors (like they did last year). They will be greeted by Ms. Henriksen, and then escorted to Room 107 (Ms. Wilson's old classroom). These students will be dismissed at 12:15 pm by Ms. Henriksen from the "Pod-B" doors. These students will line-up and be dismissed from the "Pod-B" doors, and spend their days learning in Room 107 (Ms. Wilson's old classroom)
- **Ms. Porter's former Grade 1 students** will line-up outside the exit doors located between the Primary Undercover Area and the "Pod-E" doors (like they did last year). They will be greeted by Ms. Dettling, and then escorted to Room 123 (Ms. Dettling's classroom). These students will be dismissed at 12:15 pm by Ms. Dettling from the "Pod-E" doors. From Wednesday to Friday, these students will line-up and be dismissed from the "Pod-E" doors, and spend their days learning in Ms. Dettling's classroom
- **Ms. Dettling's former Grade 2 students** will line-up outside the "Pod-E" doors. They will be greeted by Ms. Ross and then escorted to the Library. These students will be dismissed at 12:15 pm from the front of the school (school office doors). From Wednesday to Friday, these students will line-up and be dismissed from the front of the school (school office doors), and spend their days learning in the Library
- **Ms. Wilson's former Grade 2 students** will line-up outside the "Pod-B" doors. They will be greeted by Ms. Wilson and then escorted to the Library. These students will be dismissed at 12:15 pm from the front of the school (school office doors). From Wednesday to Friday, these students will line-up and be dismissed from the front of the school (school office doors), and spend their days learning in the Library

Please note that these are temporary student placements for the week of September 6th – 9th only





















All other supplies should be left at home until Monday of the following week or when the students have been assigned to their classes for the year
- All Grades 1 – 7 students need to bring a recess snack on Tuesday, September 6th
- All Grades 1 – 7 students need to bring recess snacks and lunches for the rest of the week

 - Tuesday, September 6th is a Casual Day (students do not have to wear their school uniforms)
 - From Wednesday, September 7th onwards students are expected to wear their school uniforms
